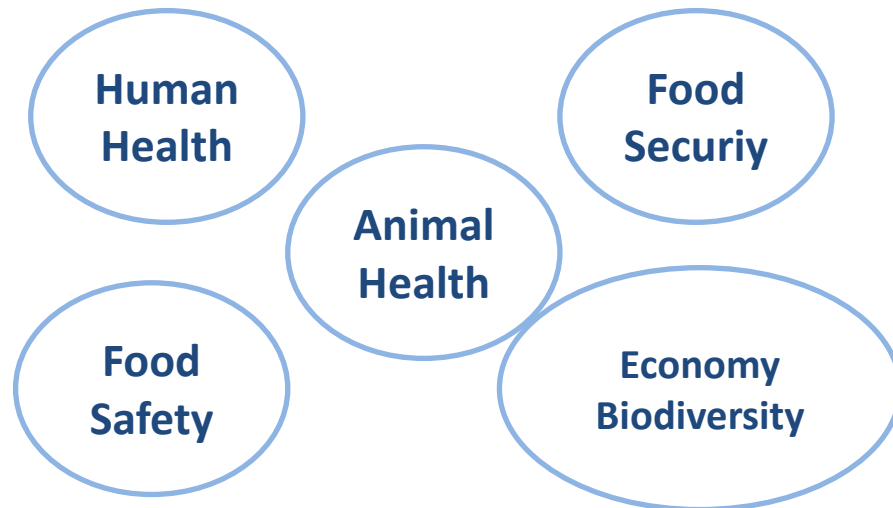
What Kind Of Public Health Do We Want? Why we need a common curriculum in veterinary public health
